Shoe Guidance

In the interests of safety, all pupils are expected to wear sensible footwear on the school premises.

Black leather, low heeled (no more than 1 inch high), lace-up or slip-on shoes with strap and enclosed heels and toes. All laces must be black. There must be no visible logos or labels.

Trouser Guidance

Trousers need to be black, sensible, modest and respectable in a loose or slim-fit style.

Skinny trousers/jeans or leggings/jeggings are not acceptable.





All skirts must be BLACK and KNEE-LENGTH and worn with BLACK TIGHTS.



Skirt Guidance

Skirts need to be sensible, modest and respectable.

Black, knee-length and non-stretchy material should be worn at all times.
