

## **National Teaching Strike Update**

Dear families,

You may be aware from the media coverage that National Education Union (NEU) has declared strike action. These are scheduled to take place on the following dates:

- Wednesday 1st February (details are shared in this letter)
- Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February (details to be shared nearer the time)
- Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March & Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March (details to be shared nearer the time)

We have assessed the situation, and this poses disruption the normal operating of the Academy. As a result, the following measures will be in place for Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February:

## Arrangements for Wednesday 1st February ONLY

- The Academy will be open as usual to Year 7 students.
- The Academy will be closed to Year 8 students.
- The Academy will be closed to Year 9 students.
- The Academy will be closed to Year 10 students.
- The Academy will be open for Year 11 Students.
- The Academy will be open for those in our HI/PI Provision.
- Students in Year 7 and Year 11 are expected in school and in normal taught lessons. **The usual legal** requirement to send your child to school applies as does their attendance record.
- Students in 8/9/10 will receive specific home learning guidance via online or other resources. **This will not** impact their personal attendance record. More guidance on this will be issued nearer the time.
- Students (all year groups) that are in our Hearing Impaired and Physically Impaired Provisions will come into school as normal and be based in the provision base.

I apologise for any disruption that this may cause and hope you understand that this is out of our control.
