




EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD'S EDUCATION!

- Families are responsible for informing us if their details have changed or if they notice they are not receiving our (very) regular communication home.









Dear Families

In the VTC (Vocational, Technical, Creative) Department, we pride ourselves on offering an exciting and engaging curriculum for all students. In Design Technology, Food Technology and Art lessons, students will use a range of quality resources to create art work, DT work and food dishes and this obviously comes at a cost to the school.

To help us cover the cost of these essential items, we ask that every child contributes £10 in September. This covers the following:

- 3 x Design Technology projects that students can take home at the end of the year
- A high-quality sketch book for them to complete their artwork in each lesson
- A range of food resources and ingredients, meaning you will only be required to send your child with the main ingredients for each practical cooking lesson. This could include resources such as foil, paper bags, containers, condiments and spices, cooking oil etc.

This amount will be payable through Parent Pay during the month of September 2024. We will send out another reminder about this in September.

CONSEQUENCES 1

- Lower academic achievements
- Poorer mental health and emotional wellbeing
- Lower chance of gaining a College place
- Restricted social and emotional development Friends!
- Increase vulnerability to safeguarding issues and criminality
- Reduced confidence around others



Schools have to monitor every student and their attendance.

Sometimes if there are continued attendance concerns, the LOCAL AUTHORITY issue fines to families.

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS CHANGING

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period.



First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the fine will

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days.

This will be reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

(within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the fine will be

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days.

No reduced rate will be offered.


Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to The Magistrates' Court.

Magistrates can issue fines of up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a Parents future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education.




