




# EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD'S EDUCATION!


## Year 11 Mock Exams

## **End of Unit Assessments**


Students in all year groups will also be undertaking end-of-unit assessments in many of their subjects and is an important topic to discuss at home.


# Year 7 – Positives 54328 Negatives 741







# Year 8 - Positive 51950 Negative 1455


### Behaviour score breakdown







# Year 9 – Positives 45101 Negatives 2006






# Year 10 – Positives 42640 Negatives 1465






# Year 11 – Positives 36864 Negatives 635

# BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Reclaiming the narrative

Andrew Hann, a historian at English Heritage states,

"History tends to be written by the powerful...it tends to be written by the people in charge...It's predominately male, it's predominately white, it's predominately middle or ruling class...While this can be a challenging story to tell, tell it we must, as it teaches us important lessons about the present as well as the past."
