

## **Transition Memo 27.6.25**

On Transition Day, Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025, we ask students to **arrive between 8:30am and 8:45am**. Please **do not drive down the school drive** to drop off your child as we have a number of disabled students arriving at this time. You can drop your child off on Edale Road where staff will be on hand to guide them into the school building. They will be greeted at the Student Services entrance by their Head of Year, Headteacher and the Senior Team and teaching staff. Students will have a welcome seminar from the Headteacher, Mr Watkin and will be given more information on what to expect. At this time the students will also get a warm welcome and introduction from key staff members, including their Team Leader (Tutor) - this is the person your child will see each morning during registration and who will guide them through our extensive RSHE/PSHE/Citizenship program - called Enrichment. After the welcome seminar, students will follow a timetable covering a number of different lessons similar to those they will have when they start in September.

- Students need to attend in their current school uniform for the day. Students will be provided with a snack and drink at break and a full lunch at lunchtime (students can bring their own if they wish).
- The school day ends at 3pm and students will leave via the entrance they arrived at and can be collected, where necessary, on Edale Road outside the school gates.
