- 4.Update the portal once you have been accepted any time before Monday the 8th of December and team NYBEP will check and verify your choice and update you if the choice has been accepted.





Introduction



Interviews are something that everyone finds challenging, whether you are going for your first interview, or whether you have taken part in lots of interviews before. It is so important that you have the opportunity to practise for your first interview, so that you feel more confident and prepared to answer whatever questions you have to face.

One thing to remember: an interview is a two-way process. It is a chance for you to "show-off", to tell the employer why they need you to work in their organisation. It is also, though, the opportunity for an employer to see whether you "fit" into their organisation.

To help you prepare for any interviews you may have this year, we have planned for you to have a practice (mock) interview with a visitor from various types of colleges and industries.

The interview will be around 15 minutes long.

Wednesday the 5th of November





Before the interview...



Think about post 16 choices and your work experience, the interviewer will likely ask you questions on this!

It is all very well to prepare answers to the questions but rehearse them and know what you are going to say; it is totally different when you are actually in the interview situation with an employer/someone sitting opposite you, that you've never met before, who is asking these questions individually. Make sure you rehearse your answers.

Check your appearance before you go to the interview— you want to make a smart and mature impression! (Is your tie on? Is your shirt tucked in?





During the interview



Think about your posture; try to feel relaxed but avoid slouching!


Keep good eye contact with the interviewer – this shows you are listening.

Try not to fidget (e.g. tapping, shuffling etc). Keep hands on your lap if needed.

If you are unsure of any questions or don't understand what you have been asked, let them know – it is absolutely fine to say "Sorry could you repeat that?" or "Can I check, do you mean...?" so you can answer the question better.

Try to give good answers with examples (don't just say "yes" or "no" too often!)

Perhaps you could see if they have availability for work experience week ... ASK (politely)!



After the interview...



You will receive verbal feedback at the end of your interview and you will receive a written feedback sheet at a later date.

Think about what went well, and what could you do better next time?




