Young Company classes run weekly during term time. Each term our passionate Young Company tutors focus on a specific theme, inspired by professional productions performed on our stage. In the Autumn we focus on our pantomime title; in the Spring we are inspired by a show in our programme; and in the Summer we work towards a full Young Company performance in our Courtyard.

Our classes are very relaxed and welcoming, giving young people an all-around creative experience. Different methods, techniques and ideas are explored during sessions, resulting in a collaborative sharing of work being created to share with family and friends at the end of term. Children will gain theatre skills along with interpersonal skills, learning to work with others and make friends.
